





Each element of xLine has a specific purpose that is visually cohesive, functionally self-evident, and structurally robust. xLine consists of box modules, shelves, and a slender slotted aluminium upright, creating limitless vertical and horizontal arrangements. It offers future-proof flexibility to add, remove, or reconfigure shelves and boxes as needs evolve.

Key Attributes

- Interchangeable box modules with or without fixed backs, drawers, desks, hampers, perforated backs, and doors permitting more than 700 configurations
- Modules can be mounted to be accessible from either side, ideal for spatial zoning, privacy, or display
- Slotted uprights and integrated mounting brackets provide limitless assembly configurations, requiring only a screwdriver for reconfiguring
- Future-proof with the flexibility to add, remove, or reconfigure shelves and boxes as needs and requirements change
- Materials and finishes engineered to endure repeated assembly/ disassembly without compromising integrity, ensuring long-term durability and reducing obsolescence and waste
- Manufactured from high-quality, fully recyclable Australian steel and aluminium

Product Features

- Available in 3 heights: 740, 1120, and 1800 (including foot)
- A basic low-profile steel shelf rated at 100kg/m2
- Common size box modules are either fully opened or fitted with a fixed solid or optionally perforated back
- Open fronted boxes can be configured with 4 door options: flip-up, fold-down, swing metal, and swing 6mm toughened glass
- Doors and drawer fitted with integrated pulls and buffers
- Metal drawer on full extension ball bearing slides
- Adjustable shelves in cupboards
- Perforated back panels
- Optional planter boxes
- Optional extendable desktop on ball bearing slides
- Häfele coat rails in 600mm wide cupboards
- Specific wall and floor mounting brackets

Materials

- Welded body made of 100% recyclable BlueScope sheet steel (with 24.2% recycled content) and Australian extruded aluminium uprights
- Materials and finishes engineered to endure repeated assembly/ disassembly without compromising integrity, ensuring long-term durability and reducing obsolescence and waste

Colours/Finishes

- Boxes are available in a range of contemporary colours
- Uprights in Satin Black, White or anodized aluminium

Perforations

• xLine offers 4 perforation patterns for the rear backing panels and optionally for boxes: Galaxy, X, Linea, and Linea Squares

Configuration

- All storage components are 880mm wide, except cupboards at 450 & 600mm wide
- All uprights are 20mm wide + 75mm depth
- First bay width is 920mm wide (20 + 880 + 20)
- Additional bay widths are 900mm wide (880 + 20)

Configuration Rules

- Free-standing room dividing requires either back-to-back configuration for stability or fixed to floor
- Storage components can face either side
- The flip-up hamper can be positioned at top only
- Fold-down hutch and desk can be positioned at centre only
- Drawers only be positioned at lowest level
- Shelves can be placed at any height
- Shelf only units require a minimum of one fixed back panel per bay
- Units combining boxes and shelves need a fixed panel on the first and subsequent third bay

The xLine system exemplifies Planex's unwavering commitment to sustainable local manufacturing and circular design.

Key environmental benefits include:

- Made in Melbourne, Australia, from fully recyclable Australian steel and aluminium
- Longevity by being able to add, reconfigure, and expand as needs evolve
- Utilization of low VOC (Volatile Organic Compound) powder coat finishes
- Designed for disassembly and reassembly using only simple hand tools
- Polymer parts labelled for segregation and sorting
- Planex factory uses a 100kW roof-mounted solar array to provide up to 25% of manufacturing electricity needs
