Welded body made of 100% recyclable BlueScope sheet steel (with 24.2% recycled content)

Colours and finishes

Paul Morris has selected 9 Fatfile™ colours and finishes: textura deep ocean, textura monument, coast satin, transformer grey gloss, signal red gloss, black ace flat, burnished copper flat, shale grey flat and crystal clear matt.

Safety Features

Interlocking anti-tilt allows only one drawer to open to help avoid tipping.

Drawer slides have positive locking of the drawer ensuring the drawer does not slide out accidentally.

Drawer cabinets have a counter balance fixed in the interior to prevent tipping if one heavily laden drawer is fully extended.
